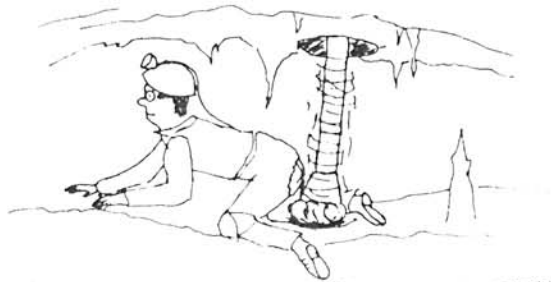

The Permian Basin Speleological Society was formed by Tony Grieco and Bill Bentley in September of 1983 and soon had, and has kept, about 30 some odd members. In January 1984, the P.B.S.S. started printing the "Splyunk." Then in March of 1984 the P.B.S.S. was chartered as the 300th grotto of the N.S.S. and has run, or tried to run, a monthly caving trip. This intrepid band of "splyunks," as they call themselves, meet on the third Thursday of every month which is currently held at the Department of Public Safety in Midland. The P.B.S.S. mostly cave in the Guad's, but have been seen in all sorts of caves across the southwest. In February 1985, the P.B.S.S. was accepted as a member of the Southwestern Region and later in June of 1985, hosted a combined Bat Cave blow out and summer regional. Throughout all of the past and short history of the P.B.S.S., and even though all but a few of the founding members have moved away, this caving club manages to somehow survive.
