

SPRING REGIONAL


To be held at the Carrizozo Malpias in New Mexico. I think that this is a lava flow area. Contact J. Lee at 505-434-6604 for more details.

We didn't get started up the canyon until about 11:00. There was a cold, bitter wind blowing, and we could find patches of snow here and there. We found the trail up the side of the canyon to the mouth of our cave wilt no trouble. The biggest trouble was hauling this creaky old carcass up the side of the canyon.
