FEBRUARY MEETING REPORT

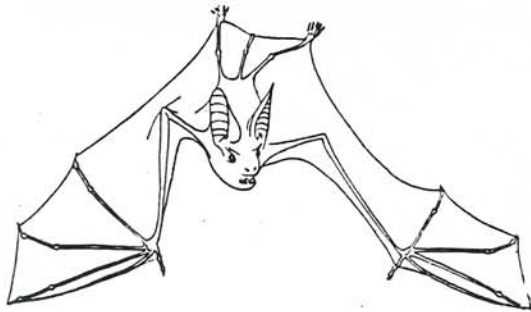
We moved the meeting back a week so that Jim and Suzy could be there to show their pictures of our trip to Ogle, and they were great pictures, Jim.

MARCH 1990 TRIP NOTICE

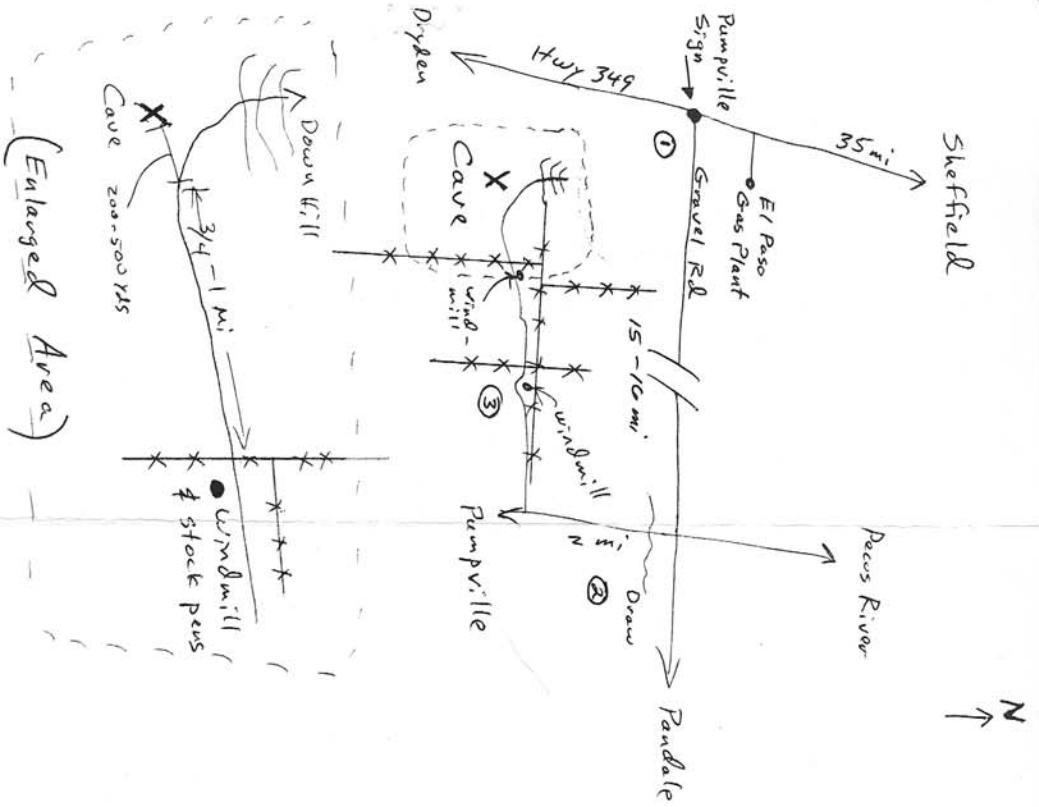
DATE: Sunday, March 25

LOCATION: Meet at the Pumpville highway sign 35 miles south of Sheffield on Hwy 349

TIME: 9:00 A.M.

CAVE: Montgomery Cave. A vertical cave with 3 drops of 20-30 feet and one drop of 100 feet.

MORE INFO --- Bill and Tom have been in the cave. Don't let Tom scare you off, though.



Montgomery Cave Trip: Meet at the Pumpville Sign on Hwy 349 at 9:00 A.M., Sunday, March 25.

- ① Go through about 6 cattle guards including the one at the highway (stay on main traveled road). Go through 1 bump gate and 4 more cattle guards. Turn right at cross roads.
- ② After turning right at crossroads go about 2 miles & turn right after 4th cattle guard onto a ranch road. Go about 1/2 mi past windmill to wire gate. Continue to 2nd windmill.
- ③ After you leave the second windmill take the road that heads right into the middle of the pasture. Go about 1 mile across the flat. Just as the road turns right and loops off the ridge you should leave the road and go straight into the pasture about 200-500 yds.
