### MEETING NOTICE

### SEPTEMBER TRIP

Hell Below has been reserved for Saturday, September 12. The cave requires a short drop, about 100 feet, but has a reputation of being technically difficult and somewhat treacherous. Walter believes the cave is spooked and refuses to enter it. Call Ken if you desire to go, as there is still one place left on the permit.

Gralin reserved McKittrick, Sand and Endless Caves for Saturday, September 26 and Sunday, September 27. There are plently of spaces on the permits, but you should call Gralin before you leave, as he's not going if he expects he may be the only one there. These are great horizontal caves, highly recommended if you haven't seen them before.

# OCTOBER TRIP

Walter has reserved Torgac cave for Saturday, October 10 and Sunday, October 11, and Crockett's Cave for Saturday, October 10. Both are located in New Mexico, about a 6 hour drive from Midland. Torgac, which has some very impressive gypsum formations, is limited to 5 people on Saturday and 5 on Sunday, and will require a guide. Walter will have maps at the meeting. As the next newsletter will probably not come out until after this trip, you should call Walter for directions and a place on the permit if you don't make the meeting.


The Guad Slut has suggested we have a Skippy Roast sometime this fall. But where are we going to get a kangaroo? How about a goat instead?
