DIRECTIONS:

1. Exit Interstate Hwy 10 at Sheffield (68 miles East of Ft. Stockton, 41 miles West of Ozona).
2. Take Hwy 349 toward Dryden. Travel 37 miles South of Sheffield.
3. Look for small sign indicating "Pumpville" turnoff. Turn left through cattleguard onto dirt road.
4. Continue on dirt roads for 20 miles. Look for and follow "PBSS" signs at intersections.

GENERAL INFO:

The Cave....Montgomery Cave is a multiple pitch vertical cave with very reliable tieoff points and clean drops, ranging from 15 to 70 feet. This will be an ideal opportunity for vertical virgins to learn the ropes. The bottom section of the cave is highly decorated with gypsum deposits.

Other caves....Horizontal caving trips are possible at Bat Cave, Amazing Maze, and Comanche Springs Cave.

Camping....We will be camped far from any stores. Bring everything you may need for the weekend, especially water! Also, please bring at least one log for the campfire, since wood is scarce in the area.
